

Introduction and General Information for Planning Events and Functions

The Country Cow Restaurant at Blair Bridge presents this function menu to assist you in planning your special event. You will find a basic list of menu suggestions and prices that we offer either in our function hall or small, more private, and personable areas of our dining room.

Please use this brochure as a guide but take into account that we are capable of much more than what is listed. We can accommodate almost any special request, specific recipe or dietary restriction. If you want or need something more or less special please feel free to ask.

Room Rental Fee

There is a minimum of 40 people to rent the downstairs function hall at The Country Cow with no room rental fee. Smaller areas of our upper dining room are available for parties less than 40. In the event that you are hosting a party and just want to rent the function room and cater it yourself there is a \$300 room charge.

Deposits and Cancellations

A \$250 non-refundable deposit is required to secure a date and time for your function. In the event of a cancellation, two weeks prior notice (or contract date) must be given to receive a full refund of your deposit. Deposits can be made by cash, check, or can be held on a credit card.

Guarantees

The Country Cow requests a guaranteed person count to be confirmed at least 48 hours in advance to prepare for food orders and actual seat placements. At the time of your event you will be charged for the actual number of people or the guaranteed number, whichever is greater.

Sales Tax and Gratuity

Please be advised that there will be an 8% Rooms and Meals tax as well as an 18% gratuity added to any base price on the functions and events menus.

Staff and Timing

Trained staff and bartenders will be provided for your function at no extra cost. There is a five hour maximum time limit for any event taking place in our function hall. We ask that if you plan to go over that time limit negotiations are made for extra charges resulting in proper cleanup. Liquor will not be served any later than 12:30 am per the NH State Liquor Commission, and the Country Cow has the right to refuse alcohol to any individual at any time. It is our policy to be ready and waiting 15 minutes prior to the starting time of your event. Early arrivals may be asked to wait upstairs until staff and room are fully prepared to ensure the high standards you deserve.

Décor

Since The Country Cow hosts a number of events including weddings, anniversaries, reunions, funeral services, live bands, etc., our room is kept with a very generic decor. Round tables seating up to six and rectangle tables seating up to ten are available. Tables are set with white linen table clothes and napkins, proper silverware, and water glasses. We allow any of our guests to decorate however they wish for their event. Open flames such as candles that are not contained are not permitted.
